

A QUAY PERFORMANCE

Set in Melbourne's harbourside Docklands precinct, the \$116M NewQuay Promenade is comprised of two shimmering towers, the AQUI (bronze tower) and Promenade (silver tower). AQUI Tower consists of 272 apartments over 22-levels and the Promenade Tower consists of 164 apartments over 18-levels. Features include a 25m indoor swimming pool, a podium rooftop garden with barbeque and picnic areas, and resort-style facilities throughout.

Hickory Group has completed the brilliant NewQuay Promenade project located harbourside in Melbourne's Docklands precinct. Comprising the shimmering Promenade and AQUI towers, the Hickory team delivered both of the Woods Bagot designed towers for client, MAB Corporation, in a single project programme. Consisting of 437 apartments over a common 5-storey podium with resort-style facilities and 4-storey multi-level car park, all apartments sold out well before completion.

AQUI Tower has a bronze sheen and consists of 272 apartments and one retail tenancy over 22 levels, measuring 76m to the top of the crown. Promenade Tower has been given a silver appearance and comprises 164 apartments over 18-levels measuring 65m to the top of the crown.

Project Manager for Hickory, Peter Frank, said that the development featured five distinct maritime colour schemes and 33 modern apartment layouts. "Residents will also have a 25m indoor swimming pool, spa, sauna and gymnasium at their disposal plus a private meeting room, residents' lounge and library. The podium rooftop garden features barbeque and picnic areas and integrated gardens."

"From a construction perspective, Hickory used driven precast and sheet piling techniques to ensure the structural integrity of

foundations," Peter explained. "Our inhouse formwork structures team was involved from the commencement of specifications right through to pour, formwork and quality control. The team includes surveyors, steel fixers, riggers and labourers, ensuring our projects have direct access to the industry's most experienced structure specialists."

One of the major challenges on the project was the high level of detail to finishes. It meant a lot of time was invested to take the concept design through to shop drawings and fabrication. "Consequently the fitoutcycle times were condensed in order to meet the completion dates," Peter said.

In addition, the structural floor-to-floor height was only 2,950mm but the design brief dictated 2,600mm ceiling heights with full height windows and full height joinery. "This required precise services coordination and ductwork layouts to deliver these requirements," Peter added. "The various window systems were procured, delivered and installed by Hickory's own inhouse façade division."

At the peak of construction, Hickory had 340 people onsite. Over 1,400 site inductions were carried out. A feature of the apartment finishes was that many of the fixtures and fittings were bespoke to the project including appliances, china basins, tapware and joinery


handles. This involved product design, prototypes and offshore manufacturing.

Hickory is one of Australia's most prolific apartment builders, with proven experience in high-quality construction fitouts. Current projects in Melbourne include the Banksia Apartment development on a neighbouring site to NewQuay at Docklands as well as Claremont Manor in South Yarra, the Parque Apartments and Opera Melbourne, both in St Kilda Road and Lakeside Apartments at Albert Park.

Hickory also has a firm commitment to continuously improving its safety processes and performance, developing strict procedures and protection systems to ensure the safe containment of materials, tools and workers on all Hickory sites.

Peter said the NewQuay Promenade development reflected the very best of Hickory's core values and quality systems. "The project is a superb addition to the Docklands' landscape and will be enjoyed by residents and visitors alike."




