The Aluma Apartments are the epitome of stylish urban living featuring flowing interiors which merge with generous terraces, and an elegant brickwork facade, ducted air conditioning, open-plan kitchens, luxurious bathroom finishes. The elevated rooftop retreat unites style, comfort and absolute convenience in one sensational cosmopolitan address.

The Aluma Apartment complex in the cosmopolitan Sydney suburb of Burwood stands as another testimony to the expertise of Novati Constructions, one of the city's renowned building companies.

Celebrating over 47 years since the company began in 1971, the family based business has emerged from their early beginnings to become a leading builder of quality projects in the Sydney region, focusing on a range of sectors including high rise residential, aged care, education, institutional and student accommodation. Operations Manager for Novati Constructions, Jason McLauchlan, said that the \$35 million Aluma residential development features 92-apartments with 2-levels of secure underground parking.

"Aluma has two buildings, with Building S offering 23 one-bedroom apartments, 15 two-bedrooms and one three-bedroom. Building C has 4-levels with 26 one-bedroom apartments, 22 two-bedrooms and five three-bedrooms, plus a lush rooftop retreat furnished with BBQ's and comfortable entertaining areas." Jason added that a highlight of the project is the design façade which features elegant brickwork and gives a stylish and sophisticated finish to the exterior.

Novati Constructions has been working on the Aluma project for two years, with an average of 100 employees and subcontractors onsite, with that number rising to 150 at peak periods of activity.

Aluma's location within the Burwood city centre, surrounded by residential housing and across the road from a public school, provided some logistical challenges for the build schedule. Jason said that as a result, the highest priority was given to the safety, environmental and quality control aspects of the project, in order to ensure full consideration of the needs of all stakeholders, especially those living in the immediate surrounds, were met. "This has been carried out successfully and efficiently without impeding the construction programme," said Jason.

"Aluma Apartments represents a great team effort between the developer, architect, specialist contractors and Novati," Jason said. "The residents will be the beneficiaries of an outstanding living environment both within their elegant apartments and in the surrounding neighbourhood with all its conveniences."

Novati Constructions holds a unique and proud position in the industry, operating under the same builders licence after 47 years of activity. They remain a 100% family owned business and the Novati family is still an integral part of the management team.

"This well balanced leadership structure sets Novati apart from their competitors in delivering quality, sustainable outcomes for our clients," Jason said. "Our approach to management promotes an ethical, responsible and accountable culture which has always been at the very core of our business. The comprehensive coverage of the greater Sydney area by Novati Constructions is illustrated by the spread of their building activity. As well as Aluma, Novati has residential projects underway in Harris Park, Turrumurra, Chatswood and St Leonards, a mixed use development in Manly and an aged care project in Camden.

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THE FINISHING TOUCH

mii Kitchen based in New South Wales, specialise in the manufacturing of luxury custom designed kitchens and joinery. Their reputation for producing a quality product made them the natural choice for the Aluma Apartments. The company were responsible for the elegant finishing touches to the Aluma Apartments' kitchens, vanity units, laundry and linen cabinets.

"We worked with Novati on some smaller projects prior to securing this contract," said Director, Daniel Macri. The work took approximately three months and the company's full time team of 35, all contributed onsite at some point during the contract.



The office team produced shop drawings for the developer and Novati to approve, using Cabinet Vision and once that was secured, the manufacturing process started at mii Kitchen's factory. "We recently moved into a new state-of-the-art factory and we're producing about 25 kitchens a week. For the Aluma Apartments we used Polytec ravine laminated boards, cut on our precision C&C Machinery," explained Daniel.

There's a lot of planning involved in producing kitchen carcasses and units for 92-apartments. Before production, the colour scheduling is arranged, to ensure any alternate colour schemes that were chosen are allocated to the correct product. The installation also requires significant logistical planning.

"Our work needed to be packaged carefully to go into the cranes to lift them to different floors. We use our own installers to ensure our high standard of quality and accuracy is followed right through to the final stage of completion," explained Daniel.

The company is currently working on 17 high end apartments at Darlington Brickworks in Sydney. The majority of mii Kitchen's work involves bespoke projects, secured through their network of project builders.


