The \$130M 900 Ann Street – Aurizon HQ is an incredibly designed 15-level building with a prestigious ground floor entrance, expansive and airy foyer with double height ceilings, and a 10-storey atrium stretching between Levels 5 and 14. The project also consists of a brick annexe to the building as a sensitive visual transition between the heritage and modern structures.

Hutchinson Builders joined with long standing partners Consolidated Properties Group (CPG) and Charter Hall to design and build a new home for freight company Aurizon at 900 Ann Street in Brisbane's Fortitude Valley. The 900 Ann Street – Aurizon HQ project is an office tower designed to integrate commercial activities with the garden setting of the historic Holy Trinity Church Precinct.

900 Ann Street – Aurizon HQ is a 15-level structure comprising a glass canopy at the ground floor entrance, an expansive double height foyer and a 10-storey atrium. The development boasts 18,991m² of office space and 200m² of retail tenancies. Two levels of basement provides 103 car parking spaces, 153 bicycle parks and End-of-Trip facilities with lockers and showers. Solar panels on the roof and rainwater collection tanks for irrigation of landscaping have contributed to the Aurizon building achieving a 5 Star Green Star Office Design v3 rating.

A brick podium and walkway connect the new building with 280m² of open community space with bench seating. Landscaping surrounding the church, rectory and parish hall has been extended to flow around the base of the 900 Ann Street – Aurizon HQ building creating a link to the green areas. Set backs to the glass curtain wall façade allow views from busy Ann Street through to the church gardens and buildings.

Hutchies' Contract Administrator Nik Cox, managed the design development and coordinated consultants for the D&C contract with work starting onsite in April 2016. With 180 tradesmen onsite during peak periods, the \$130 million project was completed within two years.

The 900 Ann Street – Aurizon HQ project includes a precast concrete spine wall and fire stairs, with in situ slabs and columns,

achieving a typical floor plan of 1,445m². The architecture of the building focuses on connection between users as well as with the outside. The entrance foyer is a light and airy double-storey space with glazed exterior walls and powder coated aluminium blade walls inside.

"Between Levels 5 to 6 we built a bleacher staircase where people can sit and give presentations; it opens up the space and leads to the main communal area," said Nik. "The massive atrium extends through Levels 5 to 14 with a changing form as it rises, it presented some unique technical challenges in terms of the construction and the mechanical services design."

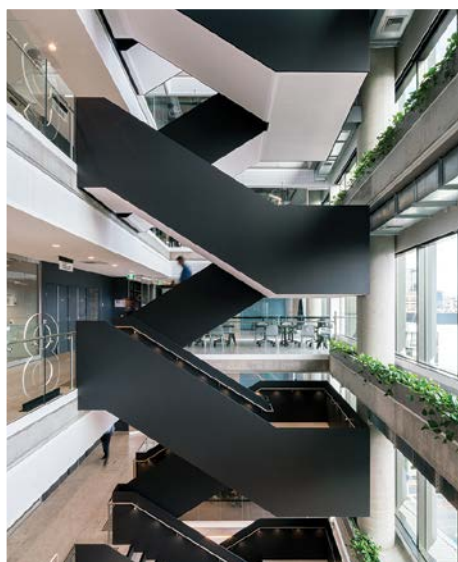
The contract called for a base build with a fitout component delivering seven cold shell levels for future tenant fitouts. "Originally Levels 3 and 4 were to be delivered cold shell but we had to return to do a fitout, Levels 10 to 14, planned for fitout were to be left cold shell. This should have caused delays to the programme but we managed to complete the work on time and the Aurizon offices are now located at Levels 2 to 9," said Nik.

The heritage listed church buildings and surrounding landscaping had to be protected during the construction process and Hutchies engaged a consultant for this job. The success of the 900 Ann Street – Aurizon HQ development led to a separate variation to upgrade the landscaping for church.

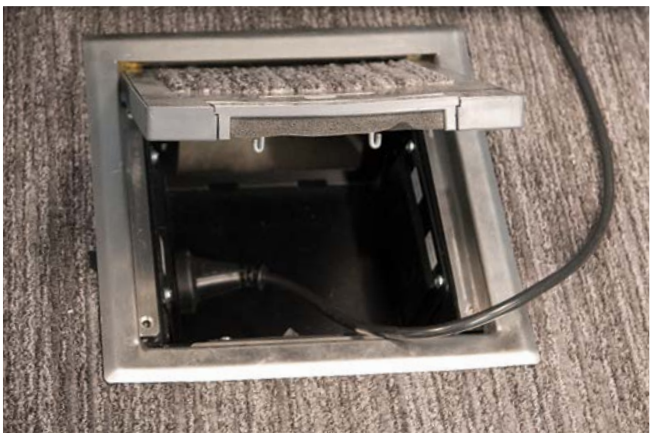
Hutchies' expertise in energy efficiency measures earned 900 Ann Street – Aurizon HQ building a 5 Star NABERS rating. At nearby 310 Ann Street, the company completed \$57 million worth of works bringing outdated building technologies into the line with some of the most advanced in the industry.

The 900 Ann Street – Aurizon HQ building is another addition to Hutchies portfolio of over 400 commercial projects Australia wide, with a combined value of \$3 billion.

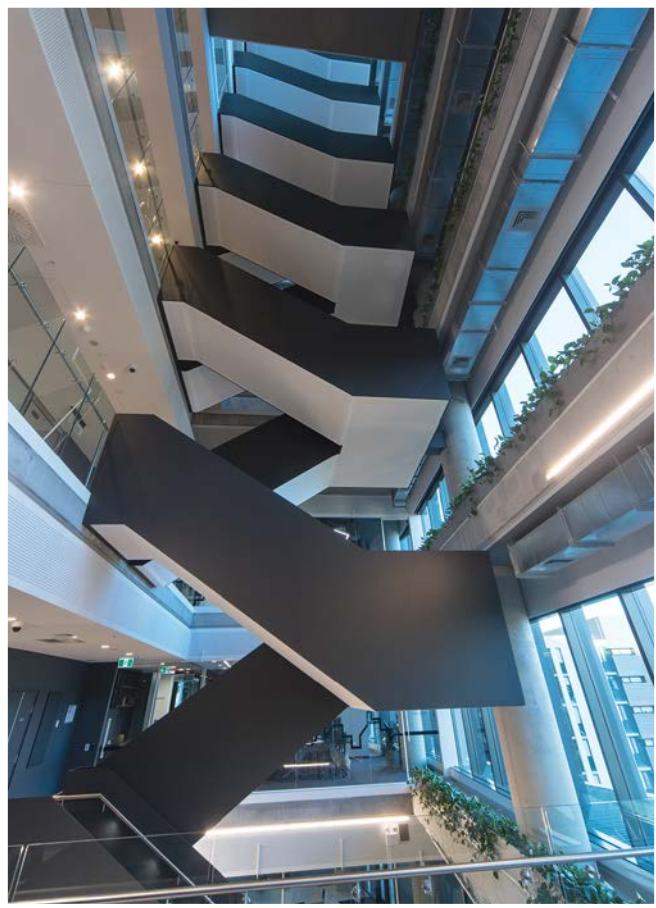

“Aurizon wanted a lot of different floor coverings in their offices including CFC (compressed fibre cement), carpet tiles and vinyl, we worked with Hutchinson Builders to detail and simplify the design, standardising the floor heights for greater long term flexibility,” said Gavin.

analysis and project support. Access floors are particularly useful for data centres and Tate provides detailed Airflow Management solutions for the general office and data centre environments.
