









bigroup Contractors Pty Ltd was engaged in December 2004 to carry out the design and construction of 299 apartments at Melbourne's landmark Chevron Hotel. This included the complete refurbishment of 68 apartments in the existing Chevron Hotel building and 231 apartments in a new building named 'Chevron Green'. The iconic Chevron and the new Chevron Green boast outstanding views to Port Phillip, Albert Park Lake and Faulkner Park, and is adjacent to more than 10 tram routes on the famous St Kilda Road Boulevard.

OH&S preparation and planning was crucial to the success of the project, particularly as it related to the partial demolition and refurbishment of the existing building. In addition to this, the refurbishment of the existing building's façade and roof with its myriad of elevations and terraces required that the safety approach to the project was second to none.

Work on the project progressed well and Stage 1 was completed to schedule, with Stage 2 (Chevron Green) currently targeted to be completed within weeks and well ahead of the contractual time frame.

Innovations on the project can be seen in the sound-proofing of the facades, with the glazed balcony screens and louvre-systems designed to block sound transmission to living areas from the 'Careflight' and Police helicopters land-

ing at the Alfred Hospital Trauma Centre less than 200 meters away. This is particularly important given the proximity of the helicopters as they fly over the north face of the development on the standard flight path.

As a community-conscious contractor, Abigroup welcomed numerous trade and community visits from industry organizations, universities and local schools in its desire to promote both safe construction and the future of the building industry.

The project's Ecologically Sustainable Development (ESD) initiatives included the requirement to recycle demolition materials; reuse of the existing hotel's swimming pool as a reservoir for reclaimed storm water; and the introduction of passive heat control through operable aluminum louvres to balconies.

Abigroup is also proving its diverse skills through other projects currently underway including a hospital at Mornington, and a golfing resort at Bass Coast. The company has also recently commenced the complete refurbishment and rebuilding of the RACV Country Club in Healesville.

Abigroup has shown itself to be committed to, and a leader in, the field of ESD building with the construction of the 5-Star Green Rated Metropolitan

Fire Brigade training headquarters in Burnley, in Melbourne's inner east. In addition, although not eligible for Green Star rating under the Australian system due to no ratings tool being available, Abigroup anticipates achieving equal to a Four Star Green rating on the RACV Country Club through the design's implementation of ESD principles.
