





The redevelopment of the Leongatha Hospital was more than ten years in the making. The team encountered latent ground conditions that required a re-design of the ground slab in some areas. They were also confronted with unidentified underground fuel tanks and asbestos. Given the large footprint of the new building and the open site, Kane were able to re-sequence the works to minimise any impact to the constructions program".

Along with Darren Parks, the delivery team for Kane Constructions comprised a Contract Manager, Site Engineer and two Site Managers who were based on site, full time in the Kane Constructions Project Office.

The overall floor space of the new building is approximately 7000m<sup>2</sup>, and the features include:

- An integrated primary & community care facility
- Obstetric procedures suite
- Operating theatre and procedure room
- Medical Imaging

The new hospital will allow Gippsland Southern Health Services to effectively maintain all existing services and to provide the capacity to delivery the outcomes outlined in the South Coast Health Plan.

The semi-domestic nature of the build meant an extensive use of prefabricated timber roof trusses. Coordination of the mechanical services through timber roof trusses required detailed planning. Kane Constructions were able to effectively handle all challenges encountered with the project.
