The \$1 billion AVEO Springfield, offers fully-integrated care within a tailor made senior community. The project features a variety of living options including 2,500 new independent and medium care living units, dementia-friendly aged care and respite facilities, a boutique child care centre and a world-class wellness facility.

Aveo Springfield, is a master planned community situated in Springfield Central, Queensland and located less than 25km from Brisbane city centre.

The ambitious and far-reaching enterprise comprises multiple stages of construction extending over 20 years, including 2,500 dwellings with a mix of apartments, assisted living, and aged care facilities.

Stage 1 was completed ahead of schedule one year after, Premier Annastacia Pallaszczuc turned the first sod of soil.

The conceptually advanced design of Aveo Springfield offers fully integrated care within an age friendly retirement community. Different types of living options within the one retirement community offer a post-traditional opportunity for aged people to benefit from connected living within an extended and supportive neighbourhood.

"This community's location together with our onsite amenities truly demonstrates Aveo's commitment to grow with older Australians by ensuring good health, providing greater living choices and giving a peace of mind not only to our residents but the wider community," said Geoff Grady, Aveo Group's Chief Executive Officer.

Policy goals based on current research about ageing have motivated Aveo Springfield to plan around international guidelines of 'ageing in place', 'active ageing' and 'productive ageing' to bring about a future looking retirement community combining a variety of living options, including independent and medium care living units, dementia-friendly aged care and respite facilities, and a wealth of additional resources such as a child care centre and a purpose built wellness facility.

Aveo Springfield has an available network of health and aged care services at its doorstep. The planned community of Springfield incorporates a pooling of facilities and resources and includes the expansion of Springfield's Health City that has been integral

from the suburb's inception in 2006. Aveo Springfield's inter-generational retirement village with its cross-section of age groups is located within Springfield's 52ha Health City and is adjacent to the Mater Private Hospital, for additional levels of care.

Stage 1 consists of 66 units for independent residential living and took 46 weeks to build. Design considerations include soft and hard landscape producing a construction that is easy on the eye and comfortable to live in as residents move through the stages of ageing. Aveo Springfield allows for mobility throughout retirement from active lifestyle to assisted care.

The ground floor of the building places emphasis on the Aveo Springfield ethos of connectedness and a sense of community with a communal lounge, hairdresser, and café area.

An ambience of wellbeing is enhanced by the extensive public pathways, ponds and landscaped features that allow residents to enjoy the lush green surroundings. The shared interior spaces are subdued and refined with soft furnishings, moderated lighting, and wide open vistas through generous use of glass and, on higher levels, individual units have substantial balconies with room for patio settings.

Aveo Group has been managing retirement facilities in Australia for over 25 years and now operates over 90 senior living communities. Aveo's 'Live Well' philosophy

is brought to bear at Springfield. Alongside an in depth and experienced knowledge of the needs of ageing residents, Aveo Group brings decades of development experience to the design table.

As service providers and developers, a balance is achieved between lifestyle and cost effectiveness. Issues of resident's mobility, the need for activity throughout the ageing process, and the importance of community to spiritual wellbeing, faith, art and nature are dealt with alongside meeting construction requirements and building regulations.

The Aveo Springfield model is designed to address ease of access. Features include stress-free navigation from street level to building entrances, comfort of movement through internal doorways and corridors as a primary design element, continuous hand rails on stairs over a metre, hobless shower recesses and a spatial design that ensures safety of residents.

Cost effective measures include reinforced walls around toilets and baths so that installation of grab rails at later stages of life are not a major undertaking.

Flex Slab System would be the most effective formwork system for the project. This system has 48% less components than the traditional formwork frame system which provides significantly less crane time which was critical to achieving the 10 week structure programme. For the columns we used Adcon wall system which due to its design strength requires minimal propping and a reduced of number tie bolts, which in turn provides a superior finish."
