Hickory Group innovates Central South Yarra in Melbourne's most cosmopolitan location under tight restraints. The \$85M residential tower reinvents modern living by maximising space, outlooking from every angle.

Founded in 1991 the Hickory Group has an impressive list of completed projects under their belt. Central South Yarra apartments is yet another one showcasing their talent and ability in building edgy, beautiful and modern buildings which are making their mark on the community.

Reaching 30 levels in the fashionable South Yarra, the most eye-catching feature of the new tower's exterior is the sweeping gold band that runs down the full length of the building's façade.

Residents can bask on the landscaped rooftop providing 360-degree sweeping views of Melbourne's skyline. The boutique project by respected developers Little Projects also comes complete with a heated pool, gym, common entertaining area fitted with kitchen, dining and lounge rooms.

It was a very competitive tender seeing Hickory Group submit an aggressive schedule and price to do the work. Project Manager Andrew McGowan speaks with pride about the 357 apartments with 291 carparks costing \$85 million, which took just over 22 months to build. By using pre-fabricated elements Hickory Group were able to reduce construction costs making for significant financial savings and precipitating a sustainable build.

"We self-perform in a lot of areas, we do our own carpentry fix, we do our own structures, we import our own façades and we install them ourselves." Being a lot more hands on than other companies made Hickory execute a cost effective construction. Eliminating the costs associated with subcontracting several key trades also eased waste removal and improved site supervision.

Being able to act quickly saw Andrew re-engineering the gold band running down the exterior's façade. Having it made from fabricated aluminium rather than a traditional composite panel meant all works could be completed without requiring external access, when the tower crane was recovered, the gold façade was then easily installed with a small crawler crane.

Having this level of autonomy and control on any aspect of a construction programme and having direct access to a lot of in-house designers and structural engineers made a big difference to the buildability of Central South Yarra. The stand out innovative feature used in the apartments was the pre-fabricated bathroom pods which were uniquely designed, engineered and detailed at Hickory's own local manufacturing facility then stringently tested and signed off prior to them being installed on site. It was the first time the pods were used with this particular client.

"The access was quite tight around Yarra Street," a 2140m² site with 38,000m² GFA. A lot of effort was expended in getting loading zones established through local council. "It was a congested street to work in and we used one tower crane, so cranage had to be very rigourously managed." A further challenge came when they re-designed the gold roof from an aluminium composite panel to a curtain wall system in order to speed up the completion of the roof.

At the start of construction Hickory employed some 15 people on Central South Yarra, this peaked with 220 people at one time. "This is less people than normal because many of the elements incorporated into the project were pre-designed and prefabricated. By using a lot of in house labour we fast tracked the design and procurement process but still maintained a superior work standard and finish."

The final delivery is set to be on time and on budget seeing the client happy with each stage of the build. This sets Hickory apart from other construction companies Andrew continues, "it is an innovative company which provides a lot of autonomy. We manage many of the key elements including formwork and concrete, crane logistics, formwork engineering, carpentry fix, bathrooms and facades all in-house."

Hickory Group employs over 450 people with a firm sense of loyalty and transparency in relationships at the backbone of their work. They have a strong focus on their social responsibility to the community. They incorporate environmental planning up front on every project making sure of they use energy saving and environmentally safe alternative materials and waste recycling when needed.

Hickory Group are also working on Parque on St Kilda Road and Fulton Lane on A'Beckett Street for Setia, New Quay Promenade for MAB in Docklands, 568 Collins, The Fifth on Lonsdale Street and La Trobe Tower in the city and Claremont Manor directly next to Central in South Yarra.
