

A BEAUTIFUL SHORE

Billbergia have recently delivered a stunning new addition to their Village Quay (VQ) community in the waterside suburb Rhodes, Sydney.

Village Quay Shores, a 20 storey residential tower offering one, two, and three bedroom apartments, demonstrates the attention to detail that Billbergia

A Sydney-based, privately owned property and construction group, Billbergia create quality living environments. With VQ Rhodes, Billbergia are putting into practice their "Create a Community" approach to residential development. Sites are carefully chosen to promote integration with the existing community, such as through accessibility to public transport and proximity to amenities, including shopping centres and schools. Only 20 minutes from the CBD, the Village Quay offers residents both a gateway to the city, and a relaxing retreat within the extensively landscaped precinct close to waterfront parks and walkways.

Enacting the ethos of "Creating Community" is Billbergia's in-house team of professionals who are specialists in every stage of development. As with other Billbergia projects, VQ Rhodes represents what Senior Project Manager Chris Kelly describes as "full beginning to end development and construction management." Billbergia are responsible for "every stage of the property life cycle from investing and land acquisition, development management, planning and design, construction, project marketing and sales." Billbergia are strategically able to ensure optimized outcomes across all these stages, including property value, fulfilling their "Creating Communities" motto, and delivering ecologically sustainable developments.

Commencing the VQ Rhodes project in 2012, VQ: Shores is Billbergia's third completed tower in the complex, along with the Parkside Building and Harbour Views (25 storeys). The final two additions, Skyview Tower (26 storeys) and the Bayside Building (6 storeys), are due for completion in 2015. As with all Billbergia apartments, VQ: Shores boast luxury finishes. The surrounding views of Homebush Bay and the Parramatta River are showcased with wall-to-wall floor to ceiling glass.

With over 25 years experience, Billbergia were more than equipped to resolve the challenges particular to this major project. Chris explains that Billbergia were required to "design and construct a foundation solution to overcome poor ground conditions due to reclaimed land and industrial usage. A piling solution was adopted which included over 860 precast driven poles over a 15000m² footprint to depths ranging from 10 to 25m below basement level to suitable rock level."

Another challenge arose from the design of the building itself, calling for the "design and construction of 20m high, 1200 diameter, reinforced concrete angular V columns to support a 26 storey cantilevered building." As Chris describes, "the control of deflection and concrete control was overcome by multi-strand post-tension concrete structure with stage stressing methodology to upper levels along with the sequencing of pours."

Founded in 1988 by brothers John and Bill Kinsella, Billbergia began as a civil engineering business sub-contracting civil construction projects around NSW. Moving into the residential housing market in the late 1990s, Billbergia continued to grow throughout the new millennium.

Billbergia still retains the hallmarks of its construction roots: as Chris notes, "coming from a civil background ... we are very plant- and structure-orientated builders, owning a large fleet of tower cranes, scaffold, and excavators." In addition to their own projects, Billbergia provides professional engineering and project management services to the residential, local government and commercial sectors of the construction industry.

In 2014, Billbergia constructed over 800 apartments. Current projects include Zen Towers, Wentworth Point (28 storey towers including 461 apartments, library, and retail sales) and Regatta Apartments, Wentworth Point (17 storey towers including 330 apartments and 6 retail shop fronts).

Billbergia Group has also recently launched its landmark Brisbane Skytower project in the heart of Brisbane's CBD. At 90 storeys, this will be Brisbane's tallest residential tower.
